INFORMATION TO THE APPLICANT

This application is to be completed and submitted in conjunction with the Temporary Restricted License Request. It shall be completed by persons who are presently under suspension/revocation for a third or subsequent alcohol/drug related offense and have been violation free for 365 days. All information submitted will be used to determine eligibility for a temporary restricted license. An investigation will be conducted by the Driver License Division to determine the validity of all information furnished.

The following information must be submitted before a determination will be made concerning eligibility for a temporary restricted license:

1. Information from at least three individuals/sources advising of your conduct and verifying you have not driven for the past 365 days may come from:
 - a. your employer
 - b. citizens in your community
 - c. local law enforcement
 - d. any others
2. A current favorable report from an addiction facility (within last six months).
3. Why you believe you need a temporary restricted license.
