# QUIT DRIVING FORM

**When you quit driving for one of the reasons listed below, you may be eligible for an identification card with the same expiration date as your current driver license at no cost.**

## I'M SURRENDERING MY DRIVER LICENSE OR PERMIT BECAUSE:

- I recognize I'm no longer competent to operate a motor vehicle, including motorcycles and mopeds. (This box must be checked in order for DMV to lift suspensions under the At-risk program. If you are an Oregon license holder and qualify, a free ID can be obtained by checking this box. See "Qualifications to get a free ID card" below.)
- OR**
- I am required to take DMV tests to retain or regain my Oregon Driving privilege. I am surrendering my license to obtain a free ID card that expires on the same date as my current Oregon license or permit.

To surrender your Oregon driving privileges for any other reason, use form 735-7206, Surrender of Driving Privileges. **THIS ACTION CANNOT BE REVERSED ONCE SUBMITTED.**

## TO REGAIN A DRIVER LICENSE OR PERMIT

You are required to meet eligibility requirements including, but not limited to:

- Paying for and passing all tests.
- Paying for issuance of the driver license.
- Submitting a Driver Medical Report, completed by a qualified health care provider, to DMV Headquarters. DMV's Medical Determination Officer will review the report and determine your medical eligibility to schedule or take tests.

After regaining your Oregon driving privileges, you may be required to periodically obtain medical recertification from DMV to retain your driving privileges.

## QUALIFICATIONS TO GET A FREE IDENTIFICATION CARD

- Your Oregon driver license or permit must not be expired.
- Your photo must be less than 9 years old.
- Mail or Fax this form as directed above. You will receive an Identification Card valid until the expiration date of your current license or permit with the picture on your current license.

**If you do not meet these qualifications for a free ID, but wish to obtain an ID card, or surrender an Oregon non-Real ID driver license for a REAL ID Identification card, please visit a DMV office or go to [DMV2U.oregon.gov](http://DMV2U.oregon.gov) to make an appointment (where available).**
