

AFFIDAVIT FOR SHARED RESIDENCE



For a Real ID Driver License, Permit or Identification Card

An applicant for an Oregon driver license, permit or identification card must be domiciled in or a resident of Oregon (ORS 807.062). This affidavit may be used by the applicant to provide proof of residence address. One additional proof of residence address in the applicant's name must also be provided.

The individual ("affiant") making the attestation on this Affidavit of Shared Residence must:

- Reside with the applicant at the residence address provided on the application;
- Accompany the applicant;
- · Complete this affidavit; and
- Provide at least one acceptable proof of the residence address.
