This Division has been advised by several dealers of a serious problem involving the ability to obtain a title to a vehicle sold to a customer with any driver license issue. The Division's current policy is that the problem must be cleared before a title will be issued. This policy has created situations where the customer has refused to clear the record, and the dealer was required to pay off the vehicle/mobile home loan due to its inability to provide a title to the finance company.

The Division has agreed to change our policy and provide the dealer a "U-title" or "Mobile Home title" as long as the following items have been accomplished:

- Dealerships must make a serious attempt to convince the customer to clear the driver license issue. This requires a certified letter be sent to the customer with a return receipt requested. Present a copy of the return receipt along with this form to obtain a title.
- The vehicle or mobile home must have a VIN verification, unless it is currently titled in Delaware or is new and was sold by a Delaware dealer.
- The dealership will only issue one temporary tag to the customer purchasing a vehicle.
- Dealership must have a Power of Attorney for the customer or have the customer's signature on all required paperwork.
- Dealers must fill out this application (MV616) and submit it with their paperwork and a copy of the return receipt from the certified letter.
