Purchaser must submit all documents received from the public agency to the county treasurer's motor vehicle office when making application for title and registration.

The seller (public agency) is to ensure the following are attached to this affidavit. Purchaser must take all these documents to the county treasurer's office when making application for title or title and registration.

- 1 Proof of verification of vehicle ownership record (verification must be applied for not more than 30 days after taking possession).
- 2 Proof of mailing of notice by certified mail to last registered owner and lienholder(s), if applicable.
- 3 Proof of publication of notice of public auction during two- (2) consecutive week period.
- 4 Odometer Disclosure Statement, form TR-59 must be attached if the vehicle is less than 10 years old, or beginning with model year 2011 vehicles, disclosure is required for 20 years.
