APPLICATION FOR HONORARY CONSUL PLATES

Visit your local deputy registrar with your letter from the president from the MNCC (Minnesota Consular Corps, USA). Letter must identify you as currently appointed by the respective government to serve in Minnesota. They will complete this form electronically Only print this application if you need to submit by mail

Honorary Consul plates are available to members of Minnesota Consular Corps.

The plates convey no special functions, no reduction of registration taxes, or "diplomatic immunity".

The plates are produced with the 3 letter Olympic Code of the country the applicant represents.Example: Belgium = BEL 1

What is the purpose of supplying the requested information?

The Department of Public Safety - Driver and Vehicle Services ("DPS-DVS") collects the information on this form to evaluate your application for honorary consul plates, and for recordkeeping purposes as required by the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13.

Am I required to provide the requested information?

You are not legally required to complete this form.

What will happen if I do not provide the requested information?

You can refuse; however, DPS-DVS will consider your application incomplete and will not be able to process it.

Who will have access to the requested information?

DPS-DVS may disclose personal information when it relates to the operation or use of a vehicle or to public safety. The use of personal information relates to public safety if it concerns the physical safety or security of drivers, vehicles, pedestrians, or property. The personal information you provide is classified by 18 United States Code section 2721 and the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13, and is subject to the disclosure in accordance with these laws. The information you provide may also be shared upon court order or provided to the state or legislative auditor.
