



Non-resident's affidavit of intent to title vehicle in North Carolina

Purpose: Active-duty service members, their dependents, college and university students, and other non-residents who intend to garage/keep their vehicle in North Carolina for at least six months out of the year¹ may use this form to apply to title their vehicle in North Carolina without a North Carolina driver license. Vehicle owners not in one of these categories need a North Carolina driver license to title their vehicle.

**The vehicle owner must provide a copy of their out-of-state driver license status when submitting this form.

Part 3: Verification (complete in the presence of a notary)

By signing below, I agree that the information on this form is true and correct to the best of my knowledge³ and that the following statements are true. I understand that making a knowingly false statement on an application for a certificate of title is a Class 1 Felony⁴.

- I will garage/keep the vehicle listed above in North Carolina for six or more months out of the year.
- I own, lease, or otherwise lawfully occupy the address where this vehicle is garaged/kept.
- If I change the address where I garage/keep my vehicle, I will notify NCDMV of the updated address within 60 days.
- I understand that if 1) my military or military dependent status changes, or 2) I no longer garage/keep the vehicle in North Carolina for at least 6 months out of the year, I will not be eligible to maintain North Carolina title or registration.
