WHAT IS A MOPED?					
Not every vehicle that looks like a moped (also known as a motorized bicycle) actually is a moped per Ohio law.					
The Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) 4501.01 and Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) Chapter 4501-23 define a moped as any vehicle with two tandem wheels or one front and two rear wheels which is capable of being pedaled and is also equipped with a helper motor. The helper motor may not have a piston displacement of more than 50 cubic centimeters, produce more than one brake horsepower, nor propel the vehicle at a maximum speed greater than 20 miles per hour (mph) on a level surface.  If a vehicle exceeds any one of these criteria, it is legally a motorcycle. Your signature below and completion of this document legally affirms that your vehicle meets the performance and equipment requirements of O.A.C. Chapter 4501-23 and that the vehicle meets the definition of a moped in Ohio. Contact the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Vehicle Information Services, P.O. (c) is capable of propelling the vehicle at a speed of <b>no greater than</b> twenty (20) mph on a level surface
