This truck is exempt from having a 1997 or newer diesel engine because it is:

- Not powered by a 1996 or older diesel engine;
- An antique vehicle;
- A motor home;
- A farm-plated vehicle or farm tractor;
- Used exclusively as a training vehicle;
- An emergency vehicle;
- An ambulance; or
- Used to transport logs, as defined in ORS 801.355.

Diesel Retrofit Information

In 2023, medium-duty trucks will need an engine that was manufactured in 1997 or later unless it is exempt, equipped with approved diesel retrofit technology, or no longer registered in Multnomah, Clackamas or Washington County. If it is exempt, you can complete the exemption and submit it with your renewal.

This change was made during the 2019 legislative session, House Bill 2007.
