INSTRUCTIONS

SALVAGED IN ERROR PROCEDURES

The following items must be submitted to PennDOT in order to reinstate and obtain a certificate of title for a vehicle which was erroneously reported as salvaged.

- 1. A verification of the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) must be completed in Section C if a legible tracing or photograph of the VIN cannot be obtained in Section B. The VIN may only be verified by a certified Pennsylvania inspection mechanic or a notary public in the employ of a Pennsylvania motor vehicle dealer. If a photograph of the VIN is used, the photograph must be signed and dated by a Pennsylvania inspection mechanic.
- 2. A Vehicle Fraud Investigator must provide written verification in Section D on the front of this form that clearly verifies the vehicle identified on the application had been physically examined by the officer and found to be the proper vehicle and that the vehicle has a current safety inspection, including the number of the inspection sticker on the vehicle.
- 3. A notarized affidavit from the applicant that clearly states what occurred must be submitted with the application. This affidavit must include the vehicle's VIN, salvage certificate number, make, body type, model year and the name of the salvage dealer that submitted Form MV-6 and the vehicle's title in error.
- 4. The certificate of salvage issued for the vehicle which was erroneously reported as salvaged must be attached and a title fee of \$58 is required.
- 5. The appropriate vehicle registration fee and a legible copy of your valid financial responsibility card are required when registration is requested. See Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees," on the Driver and Vehicle Services website at www.dmv.pa.gov for registration fees. NOTE: No temporary registration plate can be issued. You may be eligible to renew your vehicle for either a one-year or two-year registration period. Both registration periods and the required fees are provided on the registration renewal form or Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees." NOTE: If the fee listed in the "2-yr. fee" block on your registration renewal form is "N/A," your vehicle type is not eligible to renew for a two-year period.

CRUSHED IN ERROR PROCEDURES

The following items must be submitted to PennDOT in order to reinstate and obtain a certificate of title or salvage for a vehicle which was erroneously reported as crushed. Upon receipt of the documents below, PennDOT will examine the information provided and if the information is in order, the request will be processed and the vehicle record will be reinstated.

- 1. A verification of the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) must be completed in Section C if a legible tracing or photograph of the VIN cannot be obtained in Section B. The VIN may only be verified by a certified Pennsylvania inspection mechanic or a notary public in the employ of a Pennsylvania motor vehicle dealer. If a photograph of the VIN is used, the photograph must be signed and dated by a Pennsylvania inspection mechanic.
- 2. A Vehicle Fraud Investigator must provide written verification in Section D on the front of this form that clearly verifies the vehicle identified on the application had been physically examined by the officer and found to be the proper vehicle and that the vehicle has a current safety inspection, including the number of the inspection sticker on the vehicle.
- 3. A notarized affidavit from the applicant that clearly states what occurred must be submitted with the application. This affidavit must include the vehicle's VIN, title number, make, body type, model year and the name of the scrap processor that submitted Form MV-7 and the certificate of title or salvage.
- 4. If a non-repairable certificate was issued for the vehicle which was erroneously reported as crushed, it must be attached and a title fee of \$58 is required.
- 5. The appropriate vehicle registration fee and a legible copy of your valid financial responsibility card are required when registration is requested. See Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees," on the Driver and Vehicle Services website at www.dmv.pa.gov for registration fees. **NOTE:** No temporary registration plate can be issued. You may be eligible to renew your vehicle for either a one-year or two-year registration period. Both registration periods and the required fees are provided on the registration renewal form or Form MV-70S, "Bureau of Motor Vehicles Schedule of Fees." **NOTE:** If the fee listed in the "2-yr. fee" block on your registration renewal form is "N/A," your vehicle type is not eligible to renew for a two-year period.
