Any Vermont registration plate faded to a point in which its numbers and letters have impaired identification must be replaced. Replacement of faded plates is at no cost to the owner, if the fading is caused by faulty materials or a problem with the manufacturing process.

You will receive a new plate number unless you have vanity or low number plates. If you wish to keep your current registration number and it is not a vanity or low number, you must pay the replacement plate fee of $\$ 12.00$ per plate.
